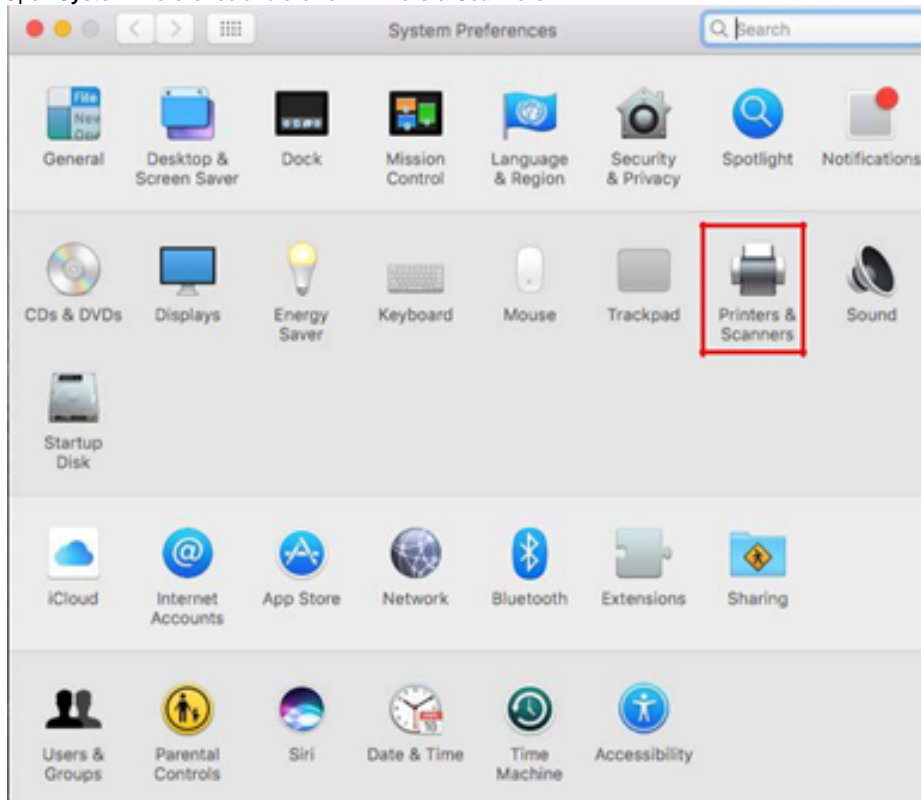


# SafeCom Printer setup for MacOS Sierra and above

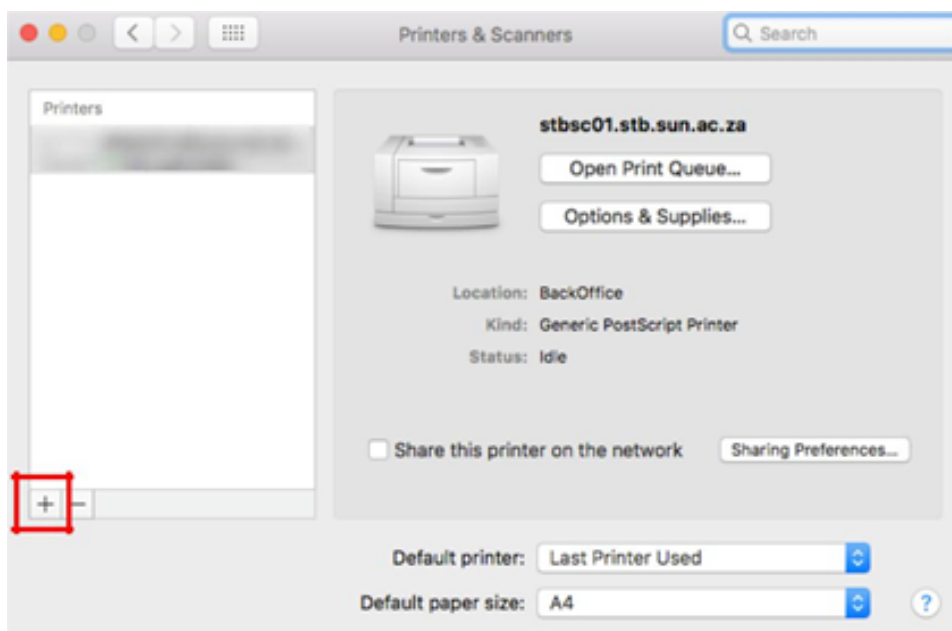
Setting up your printer MacBook Sierra and above, WiFi printing.

## Step-by-step guide

1. Open **System Preference** and click on **Printers & Scanners**



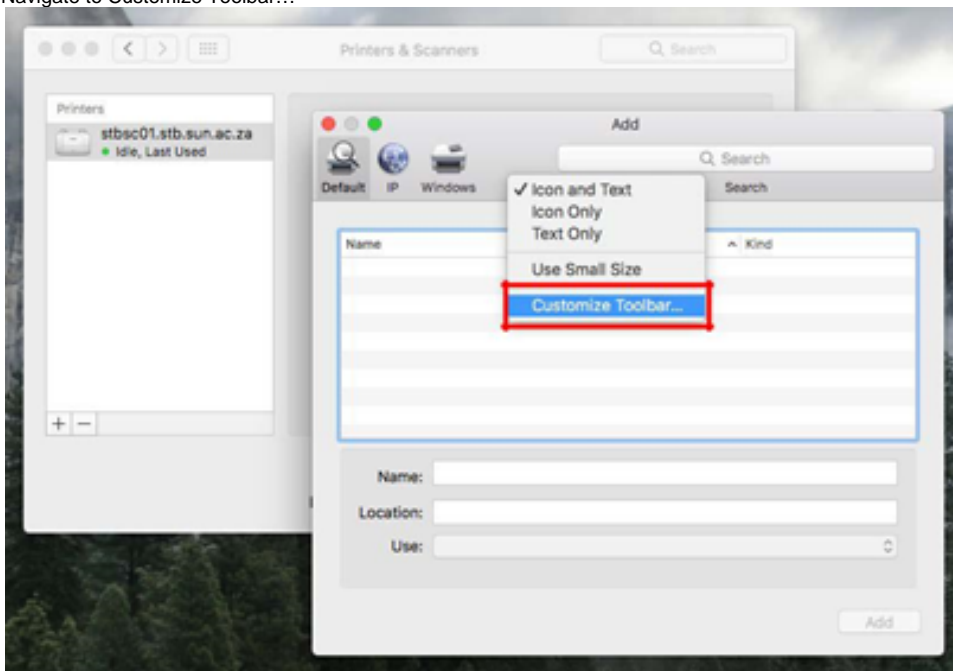
2. Click on the + icon



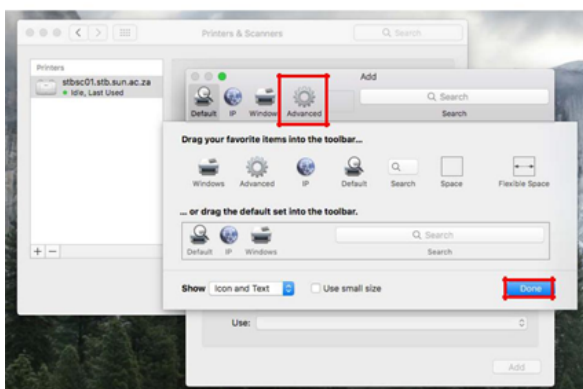
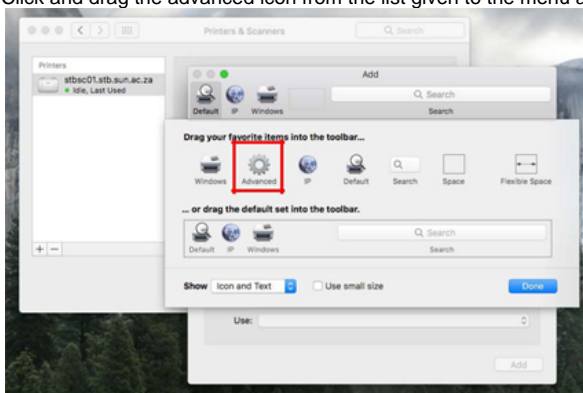
If there is no advanced icon available, do the following:

3. On your keyboard hold ctrl + left/right click to get toolbar options.

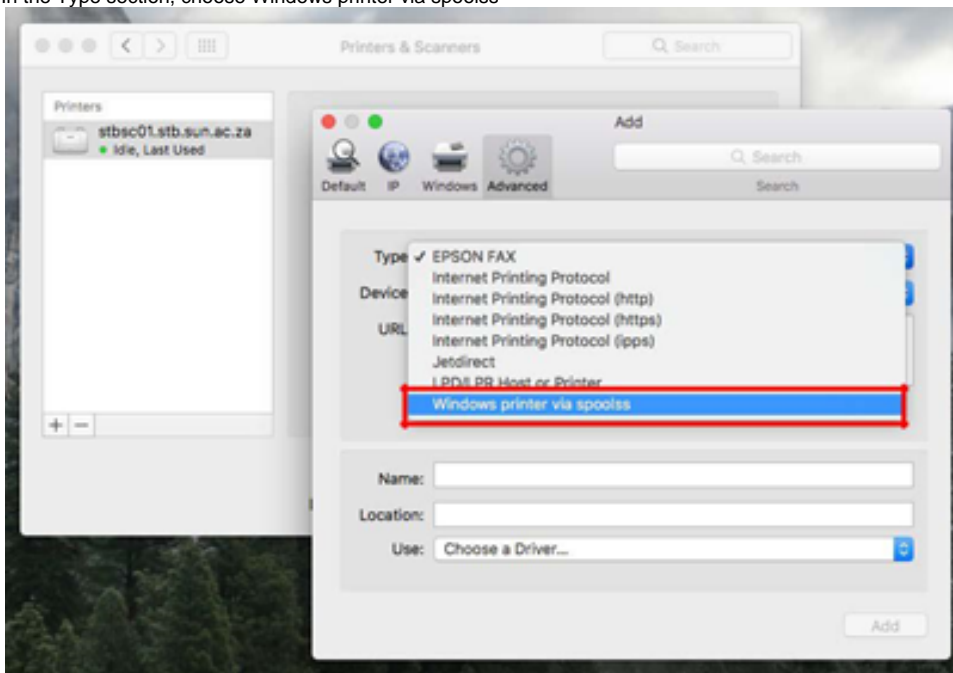
4. Navigate to Customize Toolbar...



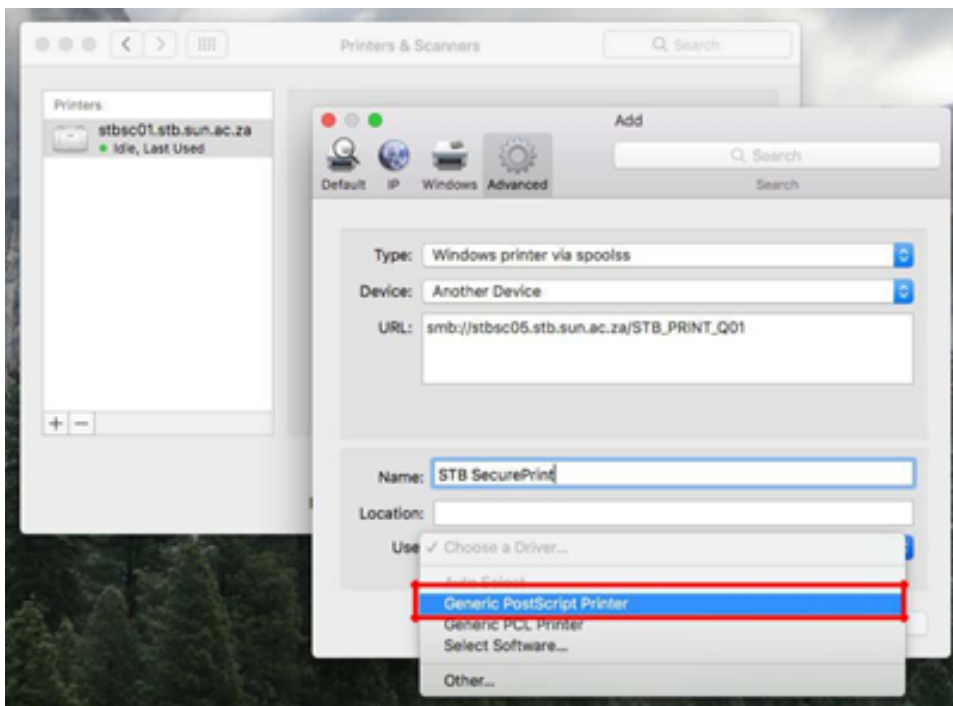
5. Click and drag the advanced icon from the list given to the menu and select Done.



6. In the Type section, choose Windows printer via spoolss

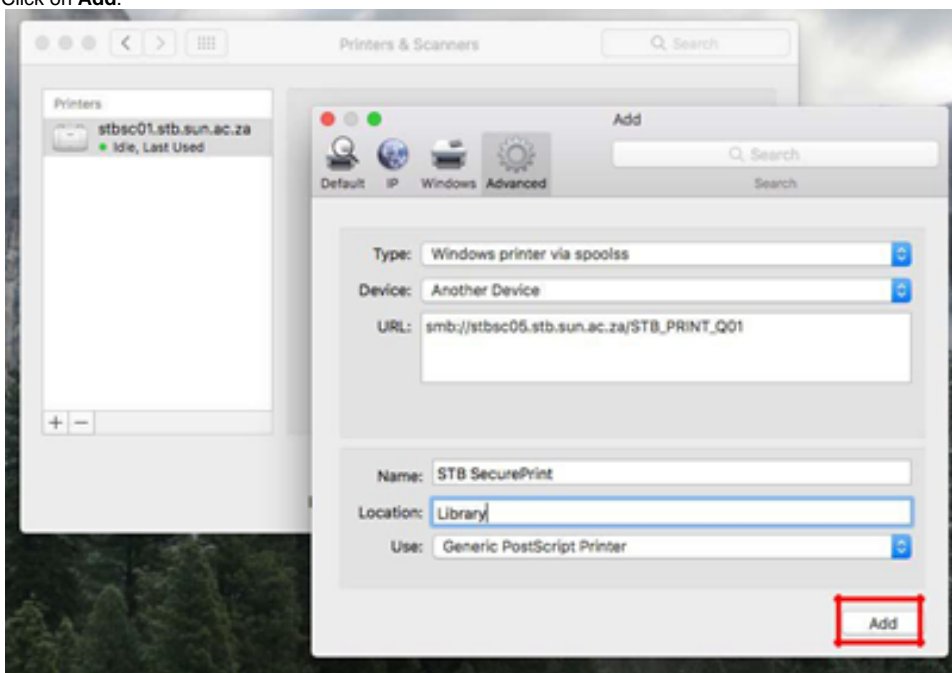


7. In the **URL** section, enter one of the following (see list):

9. In the **Use** section, choose **Generic PostScript Printer**

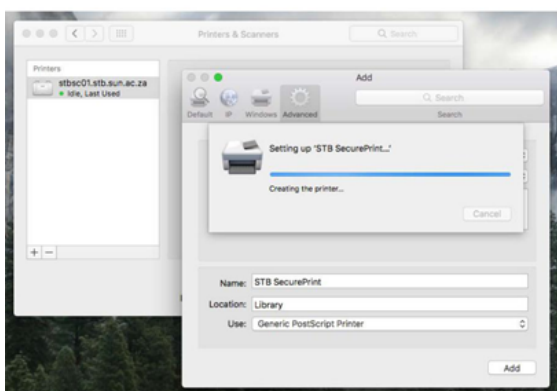
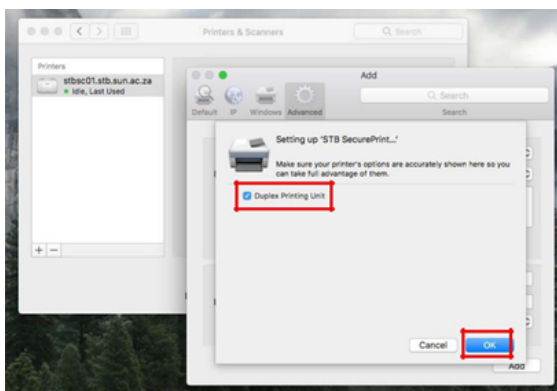

11. Click on **Add**.

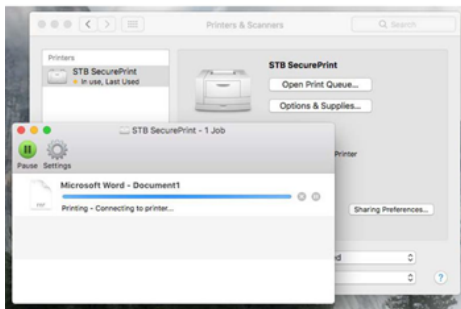
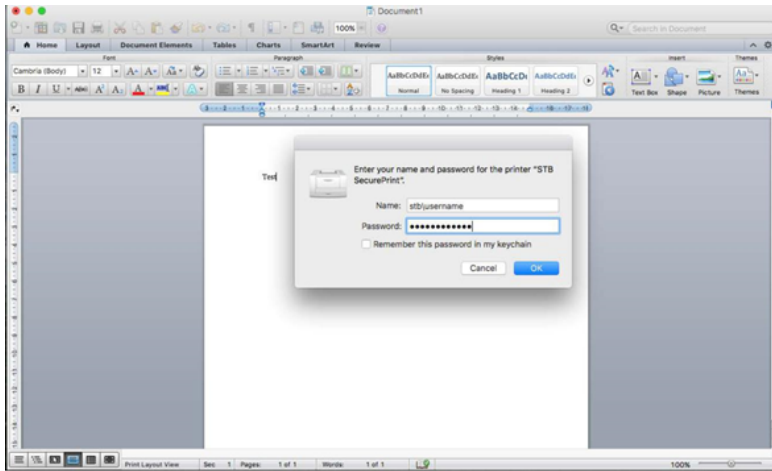


12. Select **Duplex Printing Unit** and Click **OK**.
