The Azure Portal provides students and staff of the UOS to obtain software at a discounted rate, with certain packages available to download.

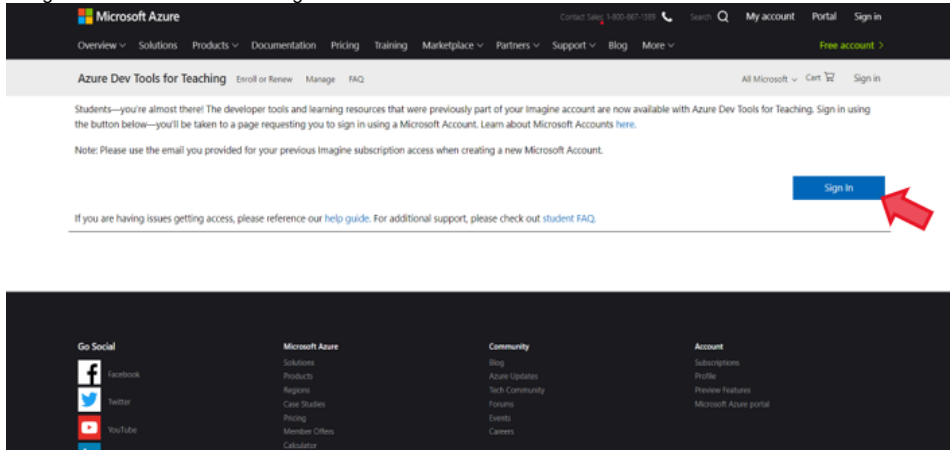

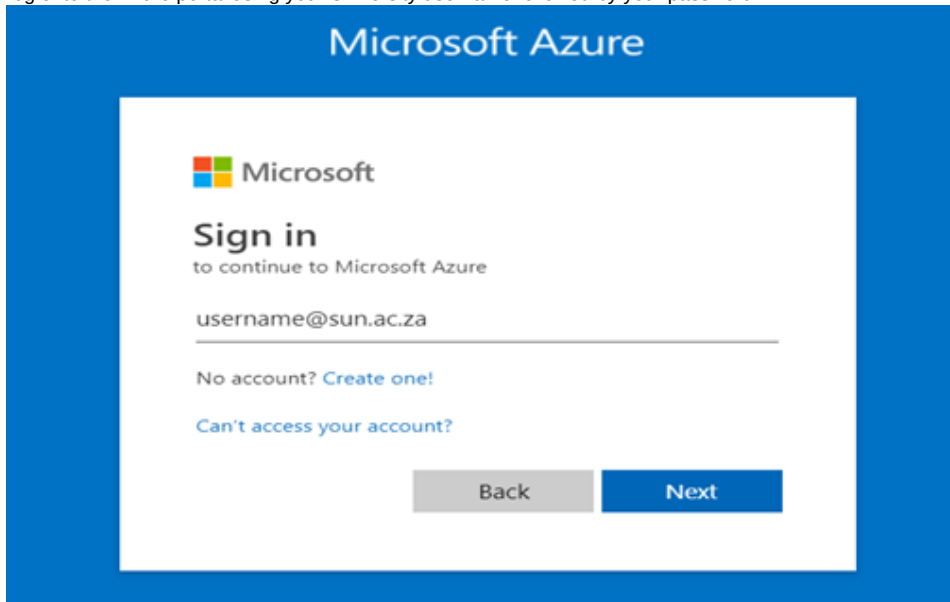

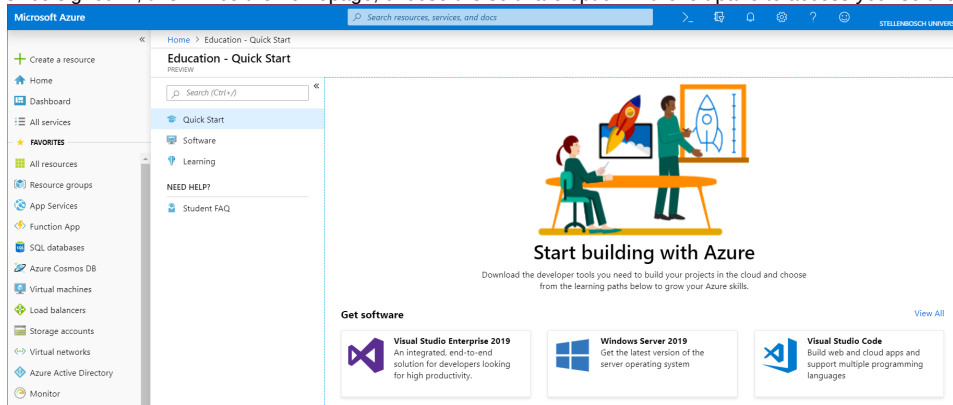
