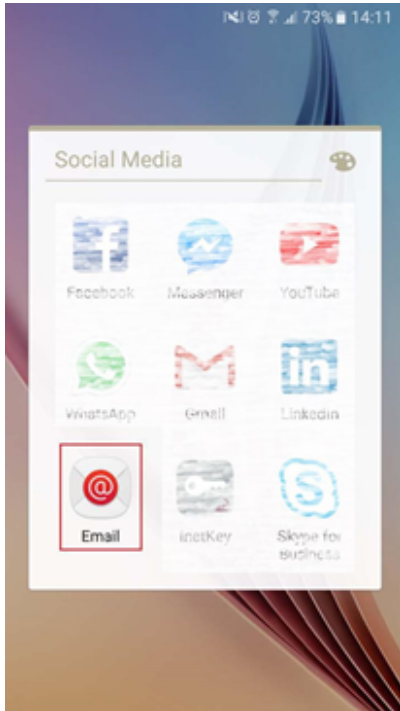


Configure Office365 e-mail on Android devices

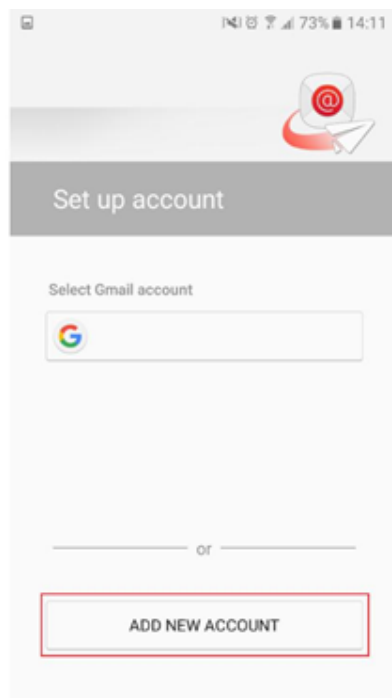
Step on how to get your emails on your smartphone.

Step-by-step guide


1. Open your **Email** app on your Android device.



2. Select **ADD NEW ACCOUNT**



3. Enter your **Username and Password** and click on **Manual setup**





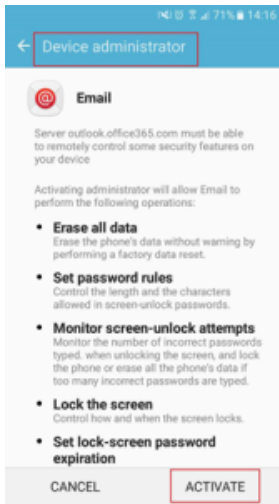
